Members are encouraged to work with Legislative Counsel in drafting their amendments. While Members may file amendments, in writing, at any time prior to or during the markup, please be aware that:

- Amendments filed prior to 4 pm will be given priority in consideration at the markup.
- The Chairman may refuse a unanimous consent request to consider the amendment as read if it is not filed before the 4 pm deadline.
- Amendments filed after the deadline may not be distributed to members until the markup.
- Amendments drafted and offered after the commencement of the markup may necessitate the Chair recessing the markup to enable the Committee staff to copy and distribute such amendments.
- For purposes of drafting amendments, please use the bills as introduced. The Chairman will not be offering a manager's amendment.
